Weekend Writing Workshop

Friday 12 to Sunday 14 August 2022 in London

Funded by The Froebel Trust

We welcome applications from a wide range of Froebelian voices.

Our weekend writing workshop is an opportunity to spend time in the company of other committed Froebelians, in the beautiful surroundings of Froebel College, London. You will be in a friendly, constructive and mutually supportive environment with time and space to write. By the end of the workshop, you will have written a blog, short article or other publication, which the Froebel Trust will publish on its website.

The weekend will incorporate presentations from experienced writers, including Professor Tina Bruce; and support from the workshop's facilitators, Catriona Gill and Jane Whinnett (Edinburgh Froebel Network).

We expect to provide approximately 15 places at this workshop.

Who can apply?

- <u>UK-based</u> educators / teachers / practitioners, students, researchers and other professionals with a keen interest and proven commitment to Froebelian education.
- New or experienced writers.
- You must commit to joining all 3 days of the workshop, which will take place in London.
- You must agree to spend the time planning & writing about an aspect of Froebelian education.

What is provided?

- 1. A warm welcome with refreshments when you arrive and register at the Froebel Trust. Participants should arrive by 10.30am on Friday 12 August.
- 2. Accommodation and meals covered by the Froebel Trust as follows:
 - Accommodation in a single en-suite room on the University of Roehampton campus on Friday night and Saturday night (and Thursday, if necessary)
 - Friday lunch and evening meal
 - Saturday breakfast & lunch (Saturday evening is free for your own arrangements / activities)
 - Sunday breakfast and lunch (the workshop will end at 2pm on Sunday 14 August)

- 3. Workshop activities including guest speakers
- 4. Spaces to work collaboratively and independently with Wi-Fi available (please bring your own laptop and charger if you wish to use a computer)
- 5. An option to visit the Froebel Archive at the University of Roehampton library
- 6. Up to £100 towards standard travel expenses in accordance with our Travel Expenses policy
- 7. A comprehensive delegate pack sent by email in advance
